Run by local volunteers providing affordable fresh produce and food items to the local community.



We are based in the centre and run every Wednesday from 10am - 1pm.

Food items will vary week to week depending on stock we receive, and a "shop" is charged at £2.00.

Community Support

The resource centre works hard to support people at different times throughout the year.

Including:

Our Christmas Toy Project — providing families with toys to help with the cost of Christmas.

School uniforms — providing new and recycled school uniforms and blazers.

Food vouchers — funding to allow us purchase food vouchers to issue to local households.

Energy support — working with WWHC to issue energy vouchers and duvets with bed sets to help keep household warmer.

What we do

The Resource Centre is your community centre and the services and activities that take place here are community led and guided by you.

In the last 12 months we have:

- Delivered a weekly food co-operative, promoting food dignity in our local area. 40 people attend each week.
- Issued 50 adult warm packs.
- Issued 200 children's warm packs.
- 300 duvets and bed sets to issue to support people through energy crisis.
- Delivered 3 online cooking classes, with 58 people completing.
- Held a children's Christmas party, with over 100 children
- attending.
- 97 children received toy parcels at Christmas.
- 285 received Aldi food vouchers.
- 346 funded places allocated to local children at our holiday sports camps.
- 1028 clients contacts through our CAB outreach.
- CAB achieved £58,789 Clients Financial Gains since October 2022.
- 350 client visits to our Digital Inclusion I.T. Hub.
- 13 people attended Digital Inclusion Hub Genealogy course.
- 49 families have received school uniform support.
- 83 art packs issued to children for our Arts and Crafts group.
- Created a Warm Welcome Space for people to access to try and help them reduce their own heating bills over the colder months.




